

THE GREEN BUILDING ORDINANCE OF MANDAUE CITY

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines recognizes the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) mandates all Local Government Units to ensure and promote the health and safety of the people, and enhance their right to a balanced ecology.

WHEREAS, overwhelming scientific evidence shows that global warming is altering the earth's normal temperature and rainfall patterns, and the human activities such as burning of fossal fuel and land use change due to rapid urbanization are considered as significant factors that contribute to the Green House Gas (GHG) balance of the earth, which in turn leads to climate change:

DRAFT ORDINANCE # 163 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE # 13-2015-1047 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE GREEN BUILDING ORDINANCE OF MANDAUX CITY"

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines recognizes the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and humany of nature.

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) mandates all Local Government Units to ensure and promote the health and safety of the people and enhance their right to a balanced ecology;

WHIREAS, overwhelming scientific evidence shows that global warming is altering the earth's normal temperature and rainfall patterns and that human activities such as burning of fossil fivel and land use change due to rapid urbanization are considered as significant factors that contribute to the Green House Gas (GMG) balance of the earth which is turn leads to distance hands.

WHEREAS, the effects of climate change are now being felt throughout the world in periods of long drought, shormal delages and floods globally known as El Niño and La Niña phenomena and more unpredictable weather conditions and recent weathernished environmental catastrophes demonstrate the humful deflects of climate change in the Philappines;

WHEREAS, these intertwined problems of climate change, social inequity, rising energy prices, and degradation of the natural systems require an integrated response that goes far beyond reducing carbon emissions:

WHEREAS, climate change adaptation must be inextricably linked with actions to create and maintain jobs, improve community livebility and public health, address social inequity and foster strong, resilient natural octoors:

WHEREAS, it is globally recognized that green building can significantly improve energy, water and resource efficiency, reduce waste and pollution generation, protect the environment and improve occupant's health and productivity:

WHEREAS, it has become imperative for both public and private buildings to include green building and landscape requirements based on local climatic, geological and topographical conditions which while shicker than current building standards are shown to be cost effective over the life of the building.

WHEREAS, in order to ensure environmental sustainability of buildings, reduce its negative impact to health and environment and consequently drive maniet transformation, there is a need for the Local Government as building regulator to formulate, adopt and implement given building regulator.

WHEREAS, the City of Mandaue has a long-standing commitment to leadership in Green Building standards, sustainable design and construction practices, efficient water and other resource conservation and management and the reduction of Green House Gas Emissions;

WHEREAS, the continuing development of real estates and land development projections must be mindful of the basic principles of conservation, environmental protection and planning patterns that consider the natural environmental.

WHEREAS, the incitutionalization of eco-friendly systems and technologies supports government efforts to reduce greenhouse gases and other hazardous emissions from buildings and other structures;

WHEREAS, the implementation of a green infrastructure policy emphasizes the need to promote and protect the interrelation of the natural ecosystem and development as these are key factors that contribute to sustainable development, empowerment of the people and urban development.

WHEREAS, the government should lead by example and have all new public buildings in Mandaue and incorporate green building principles and obtain rating as applicable; WHEREAS, emerging parts of cities are more responsive to higher building standards, becoming green building focal areas;

WHEREAS, this ordinance is in concurrence to City Ordinance No. 13-2015-1073 (The New Comprehensive trivestiment Code of Mandaue Chity shirth aims to create an environment for sustainable economic growth and Insable society through responsive governance and multi-sectoral involvement.

Wherefore, the SIXTEENTH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MANDAUE with members in session duly assembled, hereby ORDAINS that:

SECTION 1: TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as "AMENDING ORDINANCE # 13-2015-1047 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS The Green Building Ordinance of Mandaue City".

SECTION 2: AMENDMENTS — This The following amendments are hereby made to Ordinance No. 13-2015-1047 as follows:

Section 2A: ARTICLE III under Definition of Terms is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

The Building for Ecologically Responsive Design Excellence (BERDE) Rating Certification System – the BERDE Green Building Rating System is a tool to measure the environmental performance of buildings in the country. If serves as both a guideline for the design construction, and operation of sustainable buildings, and a mechanism for recognizing the environmental stewardship of ecologically responsive structures. The use of BERDE removes the burden of time and resources from the city in developing and maintaintaining an ever standard or system.

Building Height Limit (BHL) - The maximum height to be allowed for buildings/structures based on their proposed use or occupancy; The Suiking Height Limit (BHL) of any proposed building/structure shall only be as illowed under the Rule (Table VIL) of Astronal Building of God and Article I of Mandaus CIVI Zoning Critinance No.1-6-2016-1119). The BHL shall be generally measured from the established grade line to the teprosol portion of the processed building/structure. ORDN, # 1047 Series 2015 Page - 11

thereby shall continue to be effective

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in a newspaper of general conductivity.

ENACTED without objection after its second and final reading on August 28, 2015 with favorable recommendation from the referee-Committee on Laws and Ordinances, as proposed by Honorables Ernie N. Manutad, Neuta Ceniza-Layese, Disodado P. Suico, Demetrio C. Cortes, Jr., Jimmy C. Lumpapas and Elstone C. Dabon.
