BERDE

Building for Ecologically Responsive Design Excellence

BERDE is the Philippines' **National Voluntary Green Building Rating System recognized by the Philippine government**, through the
Department of Energy (DOE) under the Philippine Energy Efficiency
Project – Efficient Building Initiative.

BERDE is a tool to measure, assess, verify and monitor the environmental performance of projects above and beyond existing building and environmental laws, regulations and mandatory standards. This certification enables property market players to benchmark against a single green building rating system.

The development process of *BERDE* is guided by international recognized methodologies for developing standards, and by the Quality Assurance Guide for Green Building Rating Tools (WorldGBC, 2015).

Expanding the scope of **BERDE**, the **BERDE** — Districts was developed to promote the sustainable development of wide-scale projects, and addresses the environmental, social, and economic impacts in the planning and implementation of private communities.



The **BERDE** — Districts rating scheme applies to wide-scale projects that are at the planning or implementation stage. Private commercial estates, residential communities, industrial parks may be certified under the BERDE — Districts.

GREEN BUILDING PROCUREMENT HUB

The Green Building Procurement Hub (*Green Building/PH*) is an online platform to support green building proponents in procuring products, materials, technologies, and services for green building projects. The *Green Building/PH* aims to connect project proponents with likeminded partners in the industry to support green building projects' design, construction, and operations. In addition, the *Green Building/PH* includes green buildings to help proponents on leasing a more sustainable space for personal or business use.

Procure products, services, and building spaces you need for your green building projects through the Green Building Procurement Hub.

The Advancing Net Zero Philippines (ANZ/PH) Program was established and administered by the Philippine Green Building Council (PHILGBC).

Aligned with the global net zero program, we are promoting net zero energy through the Advancing Net Zero Philippines (ANZ/PH) Program. We encourage buildings to reduce their energy consumption through energy conservation and optimization strategies, and use on-site or off-site renewable energy for the remaining operational energy demand of the project.

Net zero energy is the conservation and optimization of the energy use in projects, and the use of the renewable energy for the project's remaining operational energy demand.

Under the Advancing Net Zero Energy Rating Scheme, projects may be certified when they demonstrate a holistic approach to energy performance, through energy efficiency and conservation and the use of renewable energy.



Conserve

Prioritize the conservation of energy using **passive design strategies** to reduce the operational energy demand



Optimize

Further reduce the operational energy demand using energy-efficient technologies and strategies.



Renew

Use **renewable energy** for the reduced operational energy demand of the project.

HEALTH+ WELL-BEING

for Buildings Tool

The PHILGBC Health and Well-being for Buildings (H+W) rating tool was formally launched as a tool to support the development of buildings that provide positive benefits to the health and well-being of users. Recognizing the positive benefits that buildings may provide to people and the community, the tool focuses on the interventions of projects and its impact to the project team, employees, and project end users.



H+W serves as a tool to measure, assess, verify and rate the performance of projects above and beyond existing building laws, regulations and mandatory standards, and its performance against social, economic and environmental priorities that affect the health and wellbeing of users.
